Your Business Association wins another award

At the end of year function for Business Improvement Districts, which was held at Villa Maria Estate, the Mangere Bridge Business Association and Mahunga Drive Business Association were jointly presented with the most Innovative Project Development Award for 2009.

The two business associations worked together on a proposal for funding under Manukau City Council's CCTV Funding Policy which allowed for a 50/50 split towards the cost of CCTV initiatives with organisations such as theirs. As a result of the proposal MCC amended their policy to enter into partnership with the two business associations. The funding proposal has now been approved and once the funds have been received Stages 4 - 7 in the Village will be completed and two cameras will be installed at either end of Mahunga Drive.

The cameras already installed have provided the police with good footage of a number of incidents. With the completion of the surveillance system throughout the village, the cameras at Mahunga Drive and at the Manukau Harbour Crossing site the movements of suspicious vehicles and persons in the area can be tracked and

CCTV footage quickly supplied to the police and Icon Security.


